



Here are the explanations regarding the sample selecting for this research:

In Banjar Regency, there is one area that specializes in cultivating catfish called the "minapolitan" of striped catfish. In this area there are 330 fish farmers who cultivate striped catfish. Because the population of fish farmers is homogeneous, the research sample has been represented by taking 10% randomly from the total sample as a whole (West, PW., 2016).

These are the steps about select the random sample (fish farmers):

- 1. Check the state of the population list (Total Fish farmers who cultivate striped catfish are 330)
- 2. Set the interval (I = N/n) + (330/33) = 10 intervals.
- 3. Assign a number (the determination of this first number is done randomly), ex: 1
- 4. The next sample member is determined by adding the interval to the first number and so on
