Profitability In Fish Breeding Business: A Case Study Of As-Syifa Pond Fisheries Business

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Abstract

As-Syifa Pond Fishery Business is located in Banjar Regency. It is engaged in a fish hatchery to help meet the needs of fish seed in South Kalimantan, which so far relies mainly on fish seed from the island of Java. The analysis used to answer the profitability of the fish hatchery business is Profit analysis, Revenue Cost Ratio (R/C) analysis, Break-Even Point (BEP) analysis, and Payback Period (PP) analysis. The results showed that the fish hatchery business in the As-Syifa Pond Fisheries Business was profitable and feasible to develop, so this business could be a model for other fish farmers to do fish hatchery business can also increase income and welfare for the community.
