Comments to the Author

Overall, the author provides an interesting topic but I am not sure it is plausible for international readers or not. The author should consider the following points to improve the article.

First, in the introduction, the author is encouraged to begin with the current issues regarding the topic discussed e.g. ethnolinguistic studies on cultural songs. The author should also correlate his/her study with relevant studies and show the distinctions. Furthermore, the significances of the studies should also be provided to show the contribution of the study to the development of research in cultural heritage. The objectives of the research are not clearly stated.

Second, the author needs to elaborate the argument of his/her choice of the research design, data collection, and data analysis.

Third, the author needs to describe more of the research result. It is not clearly communicated. The table should be elaborated.

Fourth, the author needs to review more relevant research from international or high indexed journal. The reviews are mostly from local journals (using Indonesian).

Fifth, the author needs to state the limitation of the study and suggestion for future research.
