The manuscript provides a clear and concise overview of the study, its objectives, and the methods used to achieve those objectives. The introduction presents the background information and sets the context for the study, highlighting the growing prevalence of gadgets in children's lives and the potential negative impacts of excessive gadget use. The literature gap and research questions are clearly stated, and the specific objectives of the research are outlined. However,

- 1. The abstract needs to effectively summarize the key findings and contributions of the study, namely the successful development of a prototype monitoring system for children's gadget use that meets the needs of Indonesian parents and aligns with Indonesian culture. The specific features of the system should be described, including social media monitoring, app blocking, location tracking, time management, and wireless signal deactivation.
- 2. The literature review should discuss the impact of gadgets on children's physical and mental health, including gadget addiction and the negative effects of excessive gadget use. The review must also highlight that the rise in gadget use among children still needs to be under the

supervision of parents to mitigate the risks of cyberbullying, exposure to pornographic content, and other negative impacts.

- 3. Another potential improvement could be to provide more information on the study's sample size and characteristics, as well as the specific methods used in the qualitative and quantitative data collection and analysis.
- 4. The analysis part must describe the findings of a study that aims to develop a prototype for parents to monitor their children's gadget activity while considering Indonesian culture.
- 5. Additionally, the manuscript could benefit from a more specific statements on the potential impact and implications of the study's findings, such as how the prototype monitoring system could contribute to reducing gadget addiction in children and promoting safer and more responsible gadget use.

Reviewer 2

The paper is well written. However, it needs some potential improvements before considering for publication.

- 1. The introduction could be improved by discussing the limitations of the existing studies and identifying research gaps that the study aims to address.
- 2. The review concludes by highlighting the need for research and development of security systems that parents can use as monitoring tools.
- 3. The research methodology section outlines a mixed-method approach used in the study, including qualitative system requirements data collection, system development using the SDLC-Prototype, and quantitative system evaluation. The study's concept and scope need more discussion, including the identification of research problems and the need for a security system for gadget activities in children based on the needs of parents and Indonesian culture.
- 4. The study must include several stages of analysis in a systematic manner, including needs analysis, making a prototype, coding system, system testing, and evaluation of prototypes.
- 5. The authors should elaborate on how they developed a prototype based on the parents' needs and concerns about their children's gadget activity. They should report prototype features such as Display Locked, Display Web History, Web Search Display, Schedule's View, App Management, and Daily Limits Display.
