This study highlights the importance of legislative systems, public administration, and criminal justice systems in establishing effective governance and ensuring safety and protection for individuals. The study focuses on the interrelationships between these systems in Malaysia and Indonesia.

- 1. The methodology is briefly explained. It must clearly state that the study employed a " standard legal research "approach and used both primary and secondary sources for data compilation. Content analysis was performed on the qualitative data obtained.
- The paper should separately provide some key findings, such as the differences between Malaysia and Indonesia in terms of legal systems(Islamic Sharia principles vs. civil law) and governance systems (federal vs. unitary).
- 3. The authors should suggest that communication and collaboration between legislators, public administration officials, and criminal justice agencies should be strengthened to develop crucial laws and policies for advancing criminal justice. The paper also needs to mention the need for amendments to associated constitutions for effective outcomes.
- 4. The paper should conclude by mentioning the potential benefits of the study for policymakers, researchers, and institutes involved in legislation, as well as its relevance to other Asian nations. It must indicate that the research contributes to the existing body of knowledge and presents calls for further empirical research.

Decision: Major revisions required

The provided study discusses the methodology, literature review, results, and discussion of a research study examining the interrelationships between public administration, legislative systems, and criminal justice in Malaysia and Indonesia. Here is a critical review of the text:

- 1. The methodology section briefly outlines the research approach and data collection methods. The use of qualitative research is justified based on the need for in-depth analysis of the subject matter. However, the section lacks details about the specific qualitative methods employed and how they were applied in the research.
- 2. The literature review provides an overview of the criminal justice system, public administration, and legislative systems in general. It should also mention several countries known for their effective criminal justice systems but does not establish a clear connection to the research focus on Malaysia and Indonesia.
- 3. The review lacks citations for most of the claims made, which undermines the reliability and credibility of the information presented. Including specific references and citing relevant studies would strengthen the literature review section.
- 4. The results and discussion section explores the interrelationships between public administration, legislative systems, and criminal justice in Malaysia and Indonesia. While the section provides an overview of the public administration and legislative systems in both countries, it lacks a comprehensive analysis of their interplay with the criminal justice system.
- 5. Additionally, the discussion would benefit from the inclusion of empirical findings from the research study to support the arguments made. The absence of specific findings and their interpretation limits the depth and applicability of the results and discussion section.
