#### **Decision: Major revisions required**

The paper presents the prevalence of cybercrimes in Indonesian corporations and their impact on corporate law. It outlines the problem statement, the legal framework in Indonesia, and the need for a cybersecurity law to address the challenges posed by cybercrimes. The paper also mentions the methodology used in the study and suggests that it has both practical and theoretical implications. However, there are a few areas where the paper could be improved:

- 1. The paper would benefit from better organization and clarity. Currently, the information is presented in a somewhat disjointed manner, making it difficult to follow the flow of ideas. Consider restructuring the paper to provide a clearer and more logical progression of information.
- 2. While the paper mentions the practical and theoretical implications of the research, it does not clearly state why this study is important or how it contributes to the existing body of knowledge. Providing more information on the data collection techniques would enhance the credibility and transparency of the research methodology.
- 2. The literature review provides an overview of cybercrime prevalence in corporations globally and in specific countries like the United Kingdom, Malaysia, and the Philippines. It highlights the impact of cybercrime and the role of legislation in combating it. However, the literature review relies heavily on general statements and lacks specific references to authoritative sources. Providing more specific citations and evidence from reputable studies would strengthen the literature review's credibility.
- 3. The section of findings and discussions outlines three subsections discussing cybercrime laws in Indonesia, corporate legislation regarding cybercrime in Indonesia , and the impact of cybercrime and corporate legislation on businesses in Indonesia. While it provides a general overview, the findings and discussion lack depth and critical analysis. The section would benefit from more detailed examination of specific laws and their effectiveness, as well as empirical evidence or case studies to support the arguments presented.
- 4. There should be a conclusion section that effectively summarizes the main findings of the study and highlights the importance of developing robust cyber laws and acts in Indonesia.
- 5. The recommendations section must offer specific suggestions to enhance corporate legislation and reduce cybercrimes in Indonesia . The recommendations should emphasize establishing a cybersecurity law prioritizing data protection, implementing effective cyber-security systems by businesses, and incorporating data protection laws into existing legislation.
