The research discusses a very interesting topic. Among the several studies carried out on entrepreneurial intention, very few addressed the relationship between the Muslim lifestyle and entrepreneurial intention in relation to Muslim communities. Additionally, the mediating role of intrapreneurial interest is the first time considered between Muslim lifestyle and entrepreneurial interest. I have very few concerns and suggestions for authors to improve their work.

- i. The authors should start the introduction section by describing entrepreneurial potential and its significance. They should also explain why a potential entrepreneur does not need to have a detailed business-establishing strategy. Also, there is a need to add contextual information on the topic in detail for a clear understanding of the audience with distinguished research objects in light of the existing gap.
- ii. The authors should enrich the literature review with separate headings especially linked with Entrepreneurship and Islam, Self Determination theory, and Muslim Lifestyle, for a better understanding of the readers. Also, the literature needs to be updated with the latest citations. Likewise, each hypothesis needs to be discussed separately.
- iii. Explain in detail the data collection tools utilized based on variable measuring Instruments with a detailed sampling procedure.
- iv. In the results section, authors should enrich the elaboration of findings by adding tables for each test conducted and results extracted. Also, they should add Research Instrument Validity. Moreover, Table 1, presenting Outer Model Test Results, is least explained in the text making results ambiguous for readers.

- v. The discussion and conclusion section is merged with research implications, just confining to the study novelty, which is not that novel. There is a need to discuss the implications separately and clearly state the significance of the results and their applicability per the study context in light of existing studies. There is also a need to identify potential future research areas.
- vi. There are many grammatical issues in the article. There is a need to avail of the services of professional proof editors or native speakers to enhance the manuscript's readability.

Reviewer 2

With the specific purpose of forecasting the mediating role of entrepreneurial interest between Muslim lifestyles and entrepreneurial intention in the context of Muslim communities, this study employed a quantitative research method. Conducting a questionnaire survey to collect data from the students residing in Islamic dormitories, the authors employed simple random sampling, data were collected from 169 Muslim students. Partial Least Square-Structural Equation Modeling (PLS-SEM) is employed for data analysis. Results showed that the Muslim lifestyle has a positive role in promoting entrepreneurial intention and entrepreneurial interest. Researchers also observed that the Muslim lifestyle and entrepreneurial interest have the ability to enhance entrepreneurial intention among Muslim communities. This study also provided important insights for the practitioners to enhance intrapreneurial intention among the Muslim communities by recommending that practitioners should promote the Muslim lifestyle along with the entrepreneurial interest to enhance entrepreneurial intention. It further suggests the overall significance of the topic and context. I believe that the quantitative research design used by the authors is appropriate for the study. I also found that the manuscript was overall well-structured but very, unfortunately, not well-written. Still, the current version of the manuscript needs improvements. For instance,

There is a need to elaborate on how potential entrepreneurial demands potential entrepreneurs. Also, the authors should explain that considering the high failure rate of new firms, the requirement of the constant influx of new entrepreneurs who establish new businesses and social enterprises or acquire existing businesses and social organizations is essential for the economic and social well-being of a nation. The authors should also explain that a potential entrepreneur does not need to have a detailed business-establishing strategy.

The literature review needs to be much more clearly written and updated with the latest citations. Authors should also identify the source of information for the claims like. When these psychological requirements are addressed, people display greater volitional, high-quality motivation and greater well-being, whereas when these psychological needs are not met, people exhibit various forms of decreased motivation and more symptoms..... The entrepreneurial interest also needs a separate detailed discussion. Authors should also add a Research Conceptual Framework.

The methods section is written well. However, there is a need to elaborate on the stages of Analysis, Design, Development, and Implementation. Also, data analysis techniques and tools need a detailed discussion.

The authors have conducted a detailed analysis, and the results are well-reported by the authors. However, they should add the Convergent and Discriminant Validity and composite Reliability of the Research Instrument in tabular form with proper justification and explanation. Also, assessing the Predictive Relevance of the model will add value to the analysis part with overall model fitness.

The discussion and conclusion section should be more elaborated to explain the whole research findings with significance/implications and recommendations.

There are many grammatical issues in the article throughout, and the authors are especially confused about where to use and where not to use "articles" and commas, singular or plural, etc.

Authors should double-check their citations and match them with the end-text references. Moreover, there is a need to follow the APA 7th edition to record all the references in this study.
